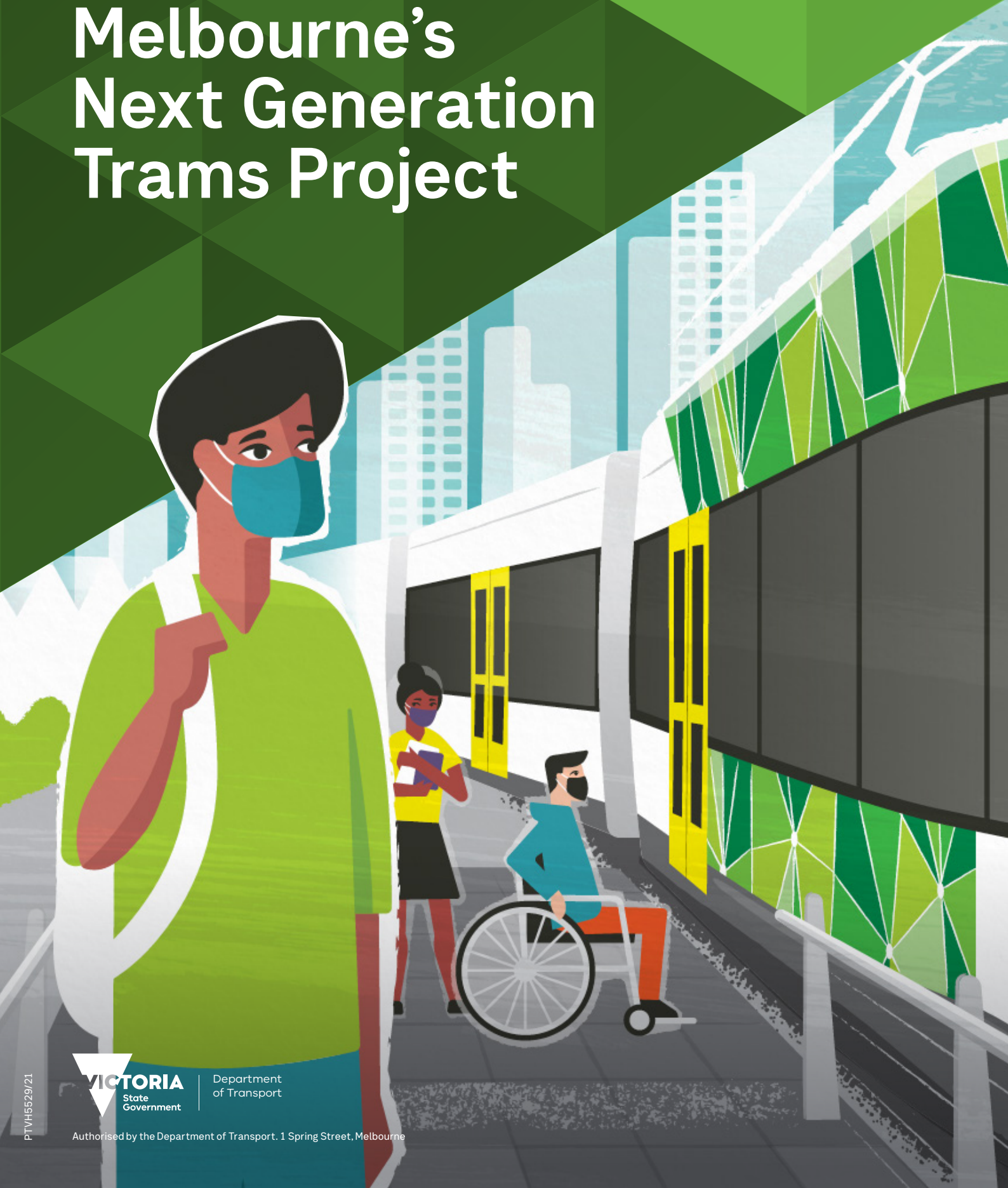

Melbourne's Next Generation Trams Project



New trams for a new era



Passenger benefits

The next generation trams will help replace Melbourne’s longest serving high-floor fleet.

New tram features:

- Latest accessibility features to make it easier for everyone to travel.
- Space for up to 150 passengers – more than double that of A and Z class trams.
- Energy efficient with on board energy storage to reduce power use.
- Modern cooling and heating for Melbourne conditions.

Tram maintenance and stabling facility

The new trams will be maintained and stabled at a proposed new state-of-the-art facility in Maidstone in Melbourne’s north west.

Local jobs

The Next Generation Trams Project will include at least 65 per cent local content to maximise local jobs and support Victoria’s rolling stock industry.

The project will generate up to 1,900 local jobs throughout the supply chain with a special focus on providing jobs and training for disadvantaged Victorians.

A manufacturer will be chosen to design, build and maintain the new trams following an evaluation process.
